Study of the Readings

Focusing the Gospel

Key words & phrases:

deny that there is a resurrection, the dead will rise

To the point: The Sadducees are fixated on dying; Jesus is focused on living. The Sadducees deny there is resurrection; Jesus proves there is by rising from the dead. The Sadducees are trapped by affairs of this life; Jesus abides with the angels and “the children of God ... who will rise.” The Sadducees’ idea of

this life ends with death: there is nothing more. Jesus knows that this life continues in newness of life. And there is even more: we already participate in what the Sadducees deny. To God “all are alive” now.

Connecting the Gospel ...

... to the First Reading: In no uncertain terms, Jesus affirms resurrection and eternal life. This “hope God gives of being raised up by him” (First Reading) fortifies us to remain faithful to God even when the

price in this life is ultimate (an extreme example of which is the death of the seven brothers). We can give our life because God gives us new life.

... to experience: In the ordinariness and busyness of our everyday living, we rarely think about either the end times or eternal life. Nearing the conclusion of the liturgical year, the Lectionary readings invite us to reflect on the reality of the end of the world and God’s promise and gift of fullness of life.

Estudio de las lecturas

Enfocando el Evangelio

Palabras y frases claves:

Negar que haya una resurrección, los muertos resucitarán

Al punto: Los saduceos están obsesionados con morir; Jesús está enfocado en vivir. Los saduceos niegan que haya resurrección; Jesús prueba que hay resucitando de entre los muertos. Los saduceos están atrapados por los asuntos de esta vida; Jesús permanece con los ángeles y “los hijos de Dios... que se levantará”. La idea de los saduceos

de esta vida termina con la muerte: no hay nada más. Jesús sabe que esta vida continúa en novedad de vida. Y aún hay más: ya participamos en lo que los saduceos niegan. Para Dios “todos están vivos” ahora.

Conectando al Evangelio

... a la Primera Lectura: En términos inequívocos, Jesús afirma la resurrección y la vida eterna. Esta “esperanza que Dios da de ser resucitados por él” (primera lectura) nos fortalece para permanecer fieles a Dios incluso cuando el precio en esta

vida es último (un ejemplo extremo de lo cual es la muerte de los siete hermanos). Podemos dar nuestra vida porque Dios nos da nueva vida.

... experimentar: En lo ordinario y ajetreado de nuestra vida cotidiana, rara vez pensamos en el fin de los tiempos o en la vida eterna. Acercándose a la conclusión del año litúrgico, las lecturas del leccionario nos invitan a reflexionar sobre la realidad del fin del mundo y la promesa y el don de Dios de la plenitud de vida.
